#### DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN SAN JOSÉ - AIRPORT RECEPTION

Upon your arrival in San Jose, the capital of Costa Rica, a Marbella Tours representative will be waiting for you with a sign with your name on it at the terminal of the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) to take you to the hotel of your choice.

#### DAY 2 ECOTOUR, TELEFERICO, GREEN JUNGLE AND THE SARAPIQUI RIVER

**Get ready to enjoy the perfect combination that Mother Nature has for you, we will start with the Cable Car ride in the rainforest, then we will have a Safari in Rio Sarapiqui and finish with an exquisite lunch in Silva Verde and its trails full of biodiversity.**

We start the tour observing the extraordinary Braulio Carrillo National Park along the way; Afterwards we will arrive to our first destination "Raint Forrest Adventure" where we will enjoy the incredible Rainforest Cable Car where on board of a huge and safe gondola we will be able to observe the canopy of the trees to feel Mother Nature in a different way, we will be in direct contact with the sounds of Mother Earth and the birds, At the end of the cable car tour we will go to Selva Verde where we will take a walk through the private trails of the place, an opportunity to meet the endemic multicolored frogs, also a spectacular river crosses this property that has a suspension bridge for your enjoyment and again immerse ourselves to live more of our flora and fauna: Afterwards we will enjoy a delicious lunch where we will recharge our batteries to start our trip without delay to the Sarapiqui River; place where we will board a very safe boat to take us to navigate for at least an hour and 15 minutes approximately, it is very possible that we will be able to observe monkeys, birds of different species, iguanas, crocodiles, sloths and much more. Once our adventure is over we will return to San Jose full of many memories to remember.

### **DAY 3 VISIT TO ARENAL VOLCANO - BALDÍ HOT SPRINGS**

**Come visit Arenal Volcano in a hidden oasis called Baldi Hot Springs, a resort with 25 thermal water pools, for a day of relaxation and self-care.**

**Your adventure for the day will be to observe the majestic Arenal Volcano, a natural phenomenon that attracts thousands and thousands of tourists every day.**

We will start our trip to the northern part of the country, on the way we will make a stop in the town of Grecia where you can learn about the history of its people and its emblematic church; next, we will make another inevitable stop in the famous town of Sarchi, internationally known for its artisans who give Sarchi the reputation as "The Cradle of Costa Rican Crafts" where you have the opportunity to purchase souvenirs such as wood and souvenirs in general at a very good price; In addition, you can take a picture with the ox cart that has the title of being the largest ox cart in the world, winner of recognition in the Guinness World Records. We will continue our journey through areas of different agricultural products like pineapple plantations, coffee, and cattle farms until we reach a typical restaurant to enjoy a delicious lunch.

We will continue our trip to La Fortuna de San Carlos to enjoy the view of the impressive Arenal Volcano and the relaxing thermal waters of BALDI Hot Springs nestled amidst the vegetation of the tropical rainforest, and fed by crystal clear waterfalls. Here you will find 25 hot spring pools welcoming all visitors. The purity of the water will make you feel like

swimming in therapeutic backwaters, accompanied by the singing of birds and the sound of falling water, inviting you to rest and relax to restore your wellbeing and quality of life.

## **Day 4 VOLCANO IRAZÚ NATIONAL PARK - BASILICA OF OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS - OROSI VALLEY.**

**Enjoy a day that combines the natural beauty of the Irazu Volcano with wonderful sites of the cultural, religious, and historical relevance of Costa Rica.**

Start the tour with a visit to the Irazu Volcano, the highest of the Central Volcanic Mountain Range; at 3432 meters above sea level is this beautiful volcano, the only point in the country where on a clear and sunny day you can see both oceans, the Pacific and the Atlantic. Enjoy

the beautiful scenery that this beautiful place offers full of fresh air. At this volcano you will feel in the clouds, once our visit to the volcano is over we will continue our way.

Arriving in the city of Cartago, the former capital of Costa Rica, you will visit the impressive Basilica of Our Lady of Los Angeles built in honor of the Virgin of Los Angeles, patron saint of Costa Rican Catholics and a site of interest to all pilgrims who gather mainly every August first in a religious festival very dear to the Costa Ricans. Additionally, you can visit the fountain of Holy Water.

Arriving at Paraíso de Cartago, a small town, but with a great human quality, we will give you a delicious lunch to recharge your batteries and continue the journey.

Be amazed by the green landscapes and the wonderful views of coffee plantations that you will find in the Orosi Valley, an area of great beauty with crystal clear rivers flowing down from the mountains.

We will visit one of the oldest churches in Costa Rica built-in 1767 by Franciscan friars, and declared historical-architectural heritage in 1920 and declared a National Monument in 1985, the famous Church of Orosi or also known as Colonial Church of Orosi, then we will return to San Jose after spending a great day.

## DAY 5 MANUEL ANTONIO NATIONAL PARK

**Manuel Antonio National Park is located on the Pacific coast of Costa Rica and is home to white-sand beaches, coral reefs and a rugged jungle. It is recognized for its great diversity of wildlife and tropical plants, we can observe from sloths to hundreds of birds, an activity you can not miss.**

We will start the route to our adventure by crossing the mountains that border the central valley, we will use route 27 where we will then take the south coast, on the way we will stop for a delicious Costa Rican breakfast to recharge batteries for the adventure.

We will enjoy beautiful views of the Pacific Ocean, picturesque villages along the coast, African palm plantations, and many other beautiful views until we arrive at Manuel Antonio National Park, we will start with a walk in the rainforest in the middle of a nature trail of the park until we reach the beach, where you can take a swim or take a tour of the trails that will allow us to observe the abundant flora and fauna of the park, especially several species of monkeys, such as the marmoset, the white-faced or capuchin monkey, howler monkey, raccoons, coatis, iguanas, sloths, white-tailed deer and all kinds of exotic birds, you can have space alone to enjoy the sea, the beach and the white sand that this magical national park has for you. After enjoying the national park and its warm beach we will head back to the restaurant where a delicious lunch awaits us before returning to the city.

## **DAY 6 POÁS VOLCANO - COFFEE TOUR IN DOKA - LA PAZ WATERFALL GARDENS**

**This tour adventure will take you to 3 magical places that will make you fall in love with Costa Rica. The first stop is the Poas Volcano at 2,574 meters above sea level, thereafter the Coffee Tour at the Doka Estate, and finally but not least important, the wonderful La Paz Waterfalls, without a doubt an experience that you can not miss.**

We will begin this beautiful and natural tour ascending towards the Poas Volcano, first, we'll make a stop at the Doka Coffee Estate, where in addition to learning about the process related to the cultivation, exemplary practices of coffee management, its natural and cultural environment, you can enjoy a delicious typical Costa Rican breakfast.

Then we will head to the beautiful POAS VOLCANO, whose main attraction is that you can access the edge of it. Not only does it have one of the largest craters in the world, but it is located in the mountainous forests of the Central Volcanic Cordillera and we will be able to learn about the gas emanations, ecosystem, and vegetation. On the way to the Volcano, you will be able to notice its different microclimates and the great diversity of agriculture, we will be able to observe strawberry plantations, flowers, ferns, and cattle farms at the same time that we will have a spectacular view of the Central Valley. The lagoon of the Poas Volcano crater will leave us in love with the desire to return.

The entire stay in the Poas Volcano National Park will be approximately 50 minutes, which are distributed into 10 minutes in the initial safety equipment and information talk, 10 minutes walk to the viewpoint of the crater of the volcano, 20 minutes of fixed permanence in the viewpoint and another 10 minutes in the return to the parking lot where transportation will be ready to get you to the next destination.

Once we finish our view of the Volcano, we will follow the mountain road to one of the main natural attractions of the area, La Paz Waterfalls Gardens Natural Park is the most visited private ecological attraction in Costa Rica. It offers the best trails near San José. The most famous waterfalls in Costa Rica, and a sanctuary for animals such as sloths, felines (jaguars, pumas, ocelots), a huge butterfly garden, a huge aviary, monkeys, a serpentarium, and frogs, among many others.

On this tour, we will enjoy an exquisite lunch.
